This eight-day photo adventure is co-hosted by Jonathan Scott, multi-award winning wildlife photographer and 'Big Cat Diary' presenter, and Phil Berry, one of Zambia's most prominent naturalist guides. Dates are Nov 3-10, with pre and post trip extensions offered Oct 31-Nov 3 and Nov 10-16.

Redding said the best time for travel is June through mid-November to enjoy these walking safaris that encompass intimate, seasonal bush camps offering personalized attention and “excellent game viewing, generally off the beaten path,” in vast, wild parks. Redding is considered an expert on Zambia and AAC is the recipient of a National Geographic Traveler - Best New Trips Award in 2009 for Zambia.
